Planning: based on analysis of the question

Organising: ahead of writing

Writing: itself

Evaluating: what have I written?

Revising: addressing errors

PLANNING

- Key topic word
- Fail to answer the question fully
- Analyse the full question
- Identify the different parts
- Clarify the specific topic
- Understand the complete requirements

PLANNING

- ENSURE YOUR ANSWER ADDRESSES THE QUESTION COMPLETELY

IT IS VERY DIFFICULT PLANNING AND
WRITING AT THE SAME TIME

Can you afford the time to plan your essay?

— You cannot afford NOT TO PLAN!

- can save you time when writing
- crucially addresses all the IELTS (International English Language Testing System) assessment criteria
- more efficient
- more effective

PLANNING

- IDENTIFY ALL THE KEY WORDS:
 - Focus on what you need to write about
 - Think about synonyms

- RANGE OF VOCABULARY
 - Brainstorming possible ideas

PLANNING: EXAMPLES

ALTERNATIVE forms of TRANSPORT should be ENCOURAGED and international LAWS introduced to CONTROL CAR ownership and use.

SYNONYMS:

ALTERNATIVE: other, different, optional
regulations

LAWS: legislation, rules,

TRANSPORT: transportation
manage, restrict

CONTROL: regulate,

ENCOURAGED: promoted, supported, pushed

CAR: vehicle, automobile

BRAINSTORMING POSSIBLE IDEAS

AGREE: Alternative forms of transport should be encouraged

Alternative transport

more cars: more pollution and traffic congestion
unhealthy and inefficient cities

public transport: more efficient and
environmentally friendly for example: subway or
metro and public bus use:

DISAGREE: International laws introduced to
control car ownership and use

Control: restrict personal freedom and choice

International laws: car= industry will strongly
object versus powerful industries... little chance
of this.
